Cheatham: From SR-12 to I-24 Spot Improvements (widening to 3 lanes, one through lane in each direction and one through lane in altering directions)

Humphreys/Perry: South of Old State Hwy 13 (Tennessee Gas Dr) to North of the I-40, Exit 143 Interchange (widen the route to a combination of a 5-lane rural section, a 5-lane curb & gutter section, and a 3-lane typical section)

Cheatham: Exit 31 Ramp Improvements

Cheatham: From SR-249 (Luyben Hills Rd) to the Davidson County line (road widening)

Hickman/Dickson: From Near SR-100 in Hickman County to Near Abiff Rd in Dickson County (Section 2) (widen from 3 lanes to 5 lanes)

Houston: From SR-13 to SR-46 Safety Improvements (miscellaneous safety improvements)

Dickson: From I-40 to SR-96 (new roadway construction)
